Warm up:
To demonstrate a warm up chosen from the syllabus with conviction and understanding.

Diction and Clarity:
To demonstrate diction throughout the performance. Focusing on the pronunciation of words. Clarity of the voice throughout the performance. Being pure and clear.

Expression:
To demonstrate characterisation of the character throughout the performance. Solid understanding of the character and story portrayed.

Discussion:

To demonstrate a good strong discussion and understanding of the questions provided.

Technique:

To demonstrate and present a full understanding of the techniques required. Being able to portray this not only through performance, but through conversation.
